



About Radio Hanukkah

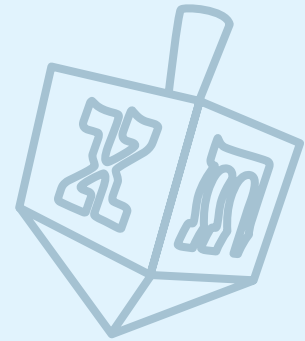
